

CLUB RULES

- 1. Act responsibly at all times.
- 2. If you observe any unsafe conditions, please report them to a Range Safety Officer immediately.
- 3. Children under the age of 10 are not permitted to shoot on the range or use the simulator.
- 4. Individuals under the age of 21 must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian who will sign a waiver and remain by their side at all times.
- 5. Firearms will only be uncased or removed from the holster within the shooting booth area. Load and unload all weapons at the bench. No uncased firearms are permitted behind the shooting booth area.
- 6. It is your responsibility to know and understand how to operate your firearm safely, ensure your firearm is in good working order and understand and use its safety features.
- 7. All first-time Members, Guests and other Athena Gun Club facility users must demonstrate proper knowledge of firearm operation and safety, or they must participate in an Athena Gun Club Firearms Rental Safety Class or Handgun Essentials Class.
- 8. Eye and Ear protection is mandatory for anyone entering the range.
- 9. Always keep the firearm action open, magazines removed and only load when ready to commence firing.
- 10. Always keep your finger off the trigger and outside the trigger guard until you are ready to fire.
- 11. Fire only when safe conditions exist: all shooters must stand in their respective shooting booth and non-shooters must stand behind the booth area.
- 12. No shooter is allowed "forward of the bench" for any reason, including use of sweeper for brass collection. Shooter must remain behind the bench at all times.
- 13. Always keep firearms pointed down range in a safe direction.
- 14. Do not pass firearms directly from person to person. Place the unloaded firearm on the bench and allow the next person to pick it up.
- 15. After you are assigned a lane, remain in that lane and shoot only your target in that lane.
- 16. Do not transfer uncased firearms from lane to lane.
- 17. The following types of ammunition are not allowed to be shot at Athena Gun Clubs: tracer ammo, incendiary ammo, steel-cored or penetrating type ammo, steel or aluminum cased ammo. Brass cased defensive ammunition is allowed.
- 18. All ammunition will be inspected by our AGC Staff prior to entering the range.

- 19. Use only the correct ammunition for your firearm as recommended by the manufacturer.
- 20. All shooting must be conducted in a safe, controlled and accurate manner, dual wielding or two gun shooting is not permitted at any time.
- 21. Any firearm not carried concealed, must be transported in a case or bag to and from the range.
- 22. Shooters who desire to shoot from the holster must be holster qualified through Athena Gun Club instructors.
- 23. Upon the command CEASE FIRE, stop all shooting immediately, put down your firearm and back away from the firing line. Shooters may not re-approach the firing line or pick up any firearm until an Athena Range Safety Officer gives the all clear signal.
- 24. Never consume alcohol or take drugs before or while shooting.
- 25. Food, drink, gum or any tobacco product is not permitted inside the range. Always remember to wash your hands after you leave the range and prior to eating.
- 26. Must be 21 years of age or older to shoot any full auto firearm.
- 27. First-time, full auto shooters at Athena Gun Club are required to take a one-time only Intro to Full Auto Class for \$25.
- 28. Any violation of the code of conduct may result in immediate removal from the range and forfeiture of Membership.
